Our Hospice can provide services to a patient in the home, assisted living facility, long-term care facility, or the Hospice Inpatient Facility located next to Columbus Regional Hospital. Medicare or Medicaid may be available to pay for these services. It is not necessary to get a doctor's referral, and Our Hospice can be contacted directly by calling (812) 314-8083.
